Country-focused research enables students to gain a greater awareness of unique cultural, historical and linguistic aspects of the target language enhancing their knowledge with valuable information relevant to their academic fields. With its focus on promoting cooperation among young scholars, the conference brings together students and novice researchers from various backgrounds. It gives an opportunity to share opinions and diverse perspectives on a wide range of relevant issues engaging students into academic debate. The conference also aims to improve public speaking skills and integrate students into the university's academic community. We invite submissions from students on relevant theoretical and practical issues in the Humanities and Social Sciences including philosophy, political science, sociology, linguistics and beyond.
